White Wines

1. OUR HOUSE WHITE - Macabeo DO Yecla, Molino Loco, Murcia, Spain 2015

Wine Style – Light and Fruity White

A lovely example of an easy drinking Spanish white wine. Soft and juicy ripe fruit flavours with hints of minerality and a long fruit-filled finish.

2. Chardonnay IGP Pays d'Oc, Monrouby, Languedoc, France 2014

Wine Style – Light and Fruity White

This unoaked Chardonnay has appealing fruit aromas and nice roundness and texture on the palate. It is well balanced with citrus flavours that linger on the finish. An elegant Southern French wine that reminds us why we enjoy good Chardonnay.

3. Pinot Grigio, Ca' di Alte, Veneto, Italy 2015

Wine Style – Light and Fruity White

This wine has delicate citrus perfumes, and white floral notes on the nose. Medium-bodied, with good balance, it has great finesse and a fresh, rounded finish. Quality Pinot Grigio should taste just like this one.

4. Montes Classic Series, Casablanca Sauvignon Blanc, Casablanca, Chile 2015

Wine Style - Crisp and Aromatic White

Always a popular choice this crisp aromatic wine is produced from handpicked grapes grown in a cool climate area near the Pacific Ocean. Lovely zesty grapefruit, lime and white peach flavours on the palate.

16. Ponte Pietra Pinot Grigio Rosato 2015

Wine Style – Light and Fruity

This is a "ramato" style of rosé. When the Pinot Grigio grape gets fully ripe it takes on a dark skin resulting in this copper coloured rose wine. Lovely, soft, juicy delicate fruit. Very easy drinking, perfect for sunny days or indeed any day... & delicious with most foods.

19. **OUR HOUSE RED - Merlot/Pinot Nero, La Cavea, Veneto, Italy 2014**

Wine Style - Lighter Style Red

Elegant aromas of berry fruit. Approachable, light velvety fruit a lovely Italian style house red.

20. **Montañar, Organic Merlot, Castilla-La Mancha, Spain 2015**

Wine Style - Medium Fruit Driven Red

Whites Wines

5. Picpoul de Pinet Coteaux du Languedoc, Baron de Badassière, Languedoc, France 2015

Wine Style - Crisp and Dry White

Crisp apple aromas with a citrus edge. A crisp, dry white that is perfect with seafood or summer drinking. Muscadet take a back seat...Picpoul is definitely the new star from the sunny South of France.

6. 16 Stops Adelaide Chardonnay South Australia 2014

Wine Style – Easy soft style, dry but has plenty of fruit

Fresh and elegant, made from top quality cool climate fruit, this wine has good fruit weight and aromas of apple and white peach. Well balanced with a lovely texture giving the wine good length on the finish.

7. Fairview, Darling Chenin Blanc, Coastal Region, South Africa 2016

Wine Style – Light and Fruity White

Made by an award winning winemaker this wine has appealing fruity aromas of melon and pear on the nose. The palate is fresh and crisp with lengthy, well balanced ripe fruit flavours complemented by a subtle limey minerality that is typical to the Darling vineyards. If you enjoy good Chenin Blanc you will love this wine!

8. Riesling, Peter Lehmann Art 'n' Soul, South Australia, Australia 2013

Wine Style - Crisp and Aromatic White

Riesling is hugely popular in Australia, New Zealand and Europe we just haven't discovered the pleasure of drinking it yet in Somerset... Fresh floral aroma's with a hint of lime leading to a palate that shows great fruit purity and zesty lime notes. The finish is clean and crisp. Wonderful with Seafood.

9. Tokomaru Bay Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand 2015

Wine Style - Crisp and Aromatic White

The rise of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc has been stratospheric, a hugely popular choice of white wine. This is a stylish and pleasingly rich Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with vibrant aromatics and a fine balance of ripe gooseberry and tropical fruit flavours leading to a lingering finish.

10. `Lois` Grüner Veltliner, Loimer, Lower Austria, Austria 2015

Wine Style - Crisp and Aromatic White

Gruner Veltliner has effected a Cinderella-like transformation in recent years and now finds itself feted like a supermodel. Given these wines' remarkable ability to pair with every food under the sun from seafood to spice, if you haven't discovered Grüner Veltliner previously then you're in for a treat. Very easy drinking, enjoy the bewildering array of delicious flavours in this refreshing wine, including peach, apple, and subtle spice. If you spot Liz our 'Wine Nerd' enjoying a bottle of white as a customer its highly likely to be this one....

11. Gavi di Gavi, Terre Antiche, Piemonte, Italy 2015

Wine Style - Crisp and Aromatic White

This wine is scented and delicate, with hints of lime zest on the nose and fruit with a lovely zip and verve on the palate. An Italian classic white that is very food friendly.

12. Cave de Hunawihr, Pinot Gris Réserve, Alsace, France 2014

Wine Style – Medium /Richer Style of White

This wine has flavours of melons, ripe pears and baked apples with a lovely weighty richness with a touch of delicious sweetness. Pinot Gris is very food friendly and wonderful to enjoy on its own. If you spot Julian relaxing in a deck chair he will be drinking this wine...

13. Albariño DO Rías Baixas, Martín Códax, Galicia & North West, Spain 2015

Wine Style - Crisp and Aromatic White

Made by a top producer of Albarino in North Western Spain by the cooling Atlantic Ocean. Fresh passion fruit, pear and citrus aromas, zesty on the palate with good flavour intensity, a fresh crisp well balanced white wine. It's the white wine the Spanish enjoy especially with Seafood! If you enjoy elegant Sauvignon Blanc this could be great alternative to explore.

14. Organic Estate Riesling, Dreissigacker, Rheinhessen, Germany 2014

Wine Style - Aromatic and rounded but with a crisp finish

An organic dry Riesling from the small wine growing area of Bechtheim. Jochan Dreissigacker's vineyards are low yielding and he uses as little intervention as possible in the winery. The result is an elegant wine with balanced flavours and a long finish. Spicy and fresh, with a lovely minerality on the nose. This Riesling finishes with mouthwatering grapefruit flavours.

15. Chablis, Laroche, Burgundy, France 2015

Wine Style – Crisp and dry classic style white

Domaine Laroche epitomises Chablis made with impeccable quality. A fresh, youthful nose with complex mineral notes. The lifted, harmonious palate shows flavours of white fruit and spring blossom complimented by the lively, mineral fruit character that typify good Chablis. Classic and elegant in style this is a lovely example of a Burgundy white wine.

17. `Cuvée Alexandre` Rosé, Château Beaulieu, Provence, France 2015

Wine Style – Crisp, dry and fruity

Light salmon pink in colour, redcurrant and wild strawberry perfumes that develop into juicy white peach and pear notes. An elegant mouthfeel and refreshing length. A classic example from the sunny South of France.

Red Wines

22. Montepulciano d`Abruzzo, Il Faggio, Abruzzo, Italy 2015

Wine Style - Medium Style Red

Always a crowd pleaser, this popular Italian red is deep ruby red in colour and has aromas and flavours of dark fruits, plums & cherries with a hint of mocha and a delicious chocolate cherry finish.

23. Cabernet Sauvignon, Excelsior, Breede River Valley, South Africa 2014

Wine Style – Medium to Big Style Red

This Cabernet Sauvignon is packed full of wonderful ripe blackcurrant fruit that is complimented by herbal notes and hints of spice from the careful oak ageing.

24. Malbec Reserve, Kaiken Reserve, Mendoza, Argentina 2015

Wine Style – Big Style Red

This full-bodied rich red wine has a full, rich mouthfeel and a soft and silky texture. Flavours of cassis and blackcurrant and ripe plums dominate the palate, interwoven with hints of chocolate, vanilla and smokey notes. A good Steak and a glass of Malbec has become an iconic food match in recent years.

25. Chianti, Da Vinci, Tuscany, Italy 2014

Wine Style - Lighter to Medium Classic Style Red

Aromas of spiced Cherry, black pepper and fresh red fruits. Well balanced with flavours of ripe Blackberry & Cherry fruit with long subtle spicy finish. A classic Italian red wine.

26. Côtes du Rhône Les Terres du Roy, Rhone Valley, France 2014

Wine Style – Medium Style Red

This Côtes du Rhône from vineyards in the sunny Southern Rhone has an enticing nose that is ripe and concentrated, full of black and red berried fruit. It is a supple, rich yet balanced a lovely example of a classic Rhone red. It's delightful to drink now, on its own or enjoy it paired with good food.

27. `I Muri` Primitivo, Vigneti del Salento, Puglia, Italy 2015

Wine Style – Big Style Red

Primitivo is the grape variety name in Italy, it is also called Zinfandel when it is grown in the USA.

It produces full bodied rich reds, packed full of ripe red berry fruit flavours and warm spices, perfect if you enjoy big style red wines.

28. Casablanca Pinot Noir, Montes Limited Selection, Casablanca, Chile 2014

Wine Style – Medium Bodied Fruit Driven Red

Lovely fruity aromas of Raspberries, Strawberries and Cherries, this medium style red is bursting with ripe smooth approachable fruit and is very easy drinking. We love it!

29. Cave de Fleurie, Beaujolais, France 2014

Wine Style – Light Fruity Red

A familiar old favourite and a truly classic French wine. From the Beaujolais region in France this wine is full of light, juicy, ripe strawberry and red fruit flavours, just perfect when a lighter style red is preferred.

Wine Style – Medium Bodied Classic Style Red

Elegant & round on the palate with lingering berry fruit, a very classy yet approachable example of a classic very well-made Claret.

32. 'Zolla' Malvasia Nera, Vigneti del Salento, Puglia, Italy 2013

Wine Style – Medium /Big Style Red

Soft, generous, rich, silky red packed full of ripe Morello Cherry fruit flavours with subtle hints of cloves. Italian wine making at its best from the sunshine region of Puglia in the South of Italy. A great choice for those who like the heavier reds from Australia, South America but with the added elegance of a European wine.

Wine Style – Medium to Big Style Red
